DESIGNER BEADING PATTERN ANN BENSON


Snakeskin cabochon surround for 30mm x 40mm oval cabochon

MATERIALS

Delicas, color A, 55 beads


- Delicas, color B, 33 beads
- Delicas, color C, 110 beads
- 15° seed beads, color D, 22 beads
- \bigcirc 15° seed beads, color A, 88 beads
- 15° seed beads, 55 beads

Also needed: 30×40 mm oval cabochon, beading nylon thread, #12 beading needle





This cabochon surround pattern is worked in tubular peyote stitch. Begin at the outer edge and thread on the two outermost rows. Step up as needed for each new round, adding beads in pattern as you PROGRESS. When you add the "points" of the diamonds at the inner edge, run the thread through the beads of the previous from point to point so there will be no visible thread.



This pattern strip can be used to make a bail in brick stitch for hanging the surrounded cabochon. Attach it to the cabochon by joining the beads shown outlined in red on the main and the bail diagram.
